

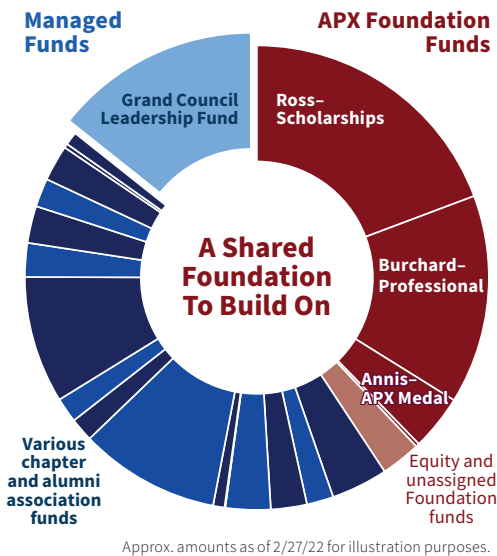
APX Foundation Status

Our professional programs and the APX Medal are now fully endowed.

The disruptions of the past couple years have limited our opportunities to meet with brothers at events like Convention to report on the Alpha Rho Chi Foundation's progress. We miss it because our main message remains **THANK YOU**.



Our average number of donors per year continues to grow and that has helped us achieve many of our recent goals. The APX Foundation currently manages assets of over \$900,000.



Based on total dollars, our largest role is as a resource for our fraternal organizations. Nearly 60% is held in managed funds invested on behalf of chapters and alumni who direct the use of their own funds for their education and professional aims. The largest of these is the APX Grand Council's Leadership Fund.

The remaining 40% of assets are under the direction of the APX Foundation itself, split among three major funds.

John R. Ross Scholarships

Awarded on the basis of both scholastics and service, Ross Scholarships recognize some of the most outstanding collegiate members of APX. In 2022, we awarded \$8,500 to Ross Scholars. Check out the next page for highlights.

Burchard Professional Fund Recently Endowed

Last year we reported on having met our goal to be able to issue Burchard Grants and help kick-start professional programs across the country. In the past year, the APX Foundation sponsored multiple programs in the fraternity's Alumni Seminar Series as well as a student/faculty event at Andronicus Chapter. Our target remains for us to **distribute \$5,000/year in grants**. We encourage chapters and alumni groups to apply for those funds.

Annis Fund for APX Medals Newly Endowed

In our last annual campaign, we asked donors to contribute to endowing the Verle L. Annis fund. **Thanks so much to everyone who helped us meet our goal** and make this fund self-sustaining. While the APX Grand Council administers the APX Bronze Medal program, we cover the expenses, such as minting medals, shipping, etc. For example, this past year \$10,000 was set aside for a restrike reserve for new medals.
